

# **Roles and Responsibilities of Peel Senior Link Board Members**

# Each Board Member Acknowledges:

1. **The Role of the Board of Directors** is to govern the affairs of the Corporation and enable the Corporation to achieve its purposes within the framework of relevant legislation and standards. The Board as a whole is responsible and accountable for exercising good stewardship of the Corporation on behalf of the trust placed in it by its stakeholders.

# 2. Major Duties of the Board include:

- governing the Corporation through broad policies, strategic and planning objectives approved by the Board
- recruiting and evaluating a CEO responsible for the administration of the Corporation within the delegated responsibilities approved by the Board
- approving strategic and other key plans and performance metrics
- key plans to include:
  - -an annual business/operating plan
  - -an annual budget and compensation plans
  - -human resources
  - -quality assurance and safety
  - -information management
  - -communications
- reviewing performance metric reports on annual objectives and strategic goals
- providing oversight for all aspects of the planning, management and delivery of the Corporation's services and operations
- reporting to stakeholders on the activities and finances of the Corporation

# 3. Specific Duties and Requirements of Board Members include:

- commitment to the Vision, Mission, and Values of Peel Senior Link
- adherence to its governance policies, by-laws and Oath of Office and Confidentiality Agreement
- commitment to being an informed participant in the work of the Board
- reliable attendance at Board meetings and active participation in the Board's deliberations and decisions
- participation in committee and other Board work
- support and assistance in developing and maintaining positive relations among the Board, staff, stakeholders and the community to enhance Peel Senior Link's mission
